## Cuckoo flower or Lady's Smock

*Cardamine pratensis.*

This is a pretty flower with four equal-sized pink or white petals. The flowers are on a straight stalk and the leaves are divided. It is often found growing amongst grass, on verges in the towns and in damp meadows in the country. It blooms in the spring and it appears at the same time as the cuckoo returns.

## Ground Ivy

*Glechoma hederacea*

This is a low-growing plant with purple coloured flowers. It is not really a type of ivy and is actually in the same family of plants as mint. The leaves are soft and hairy and are on long stalks. The flowers are found in a circle at the base of the leaves. It is found in woods, hedge banks and bare places. It often grows in clumps.

## Hawthorn

*Crataegus monogyna*

Hedgerows full of white blossom in May are very likely be full of hawthorn. This is a shrub or small tree. The flower-heads have lots of flowers, each with 5 petals. The leaves have 5-6 rounded parts to them (lobes). The branches are thorny so take care. It sometimes is called "May" after the month in which it is in bloom.

## Bluebells

*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*

Lovely blue flowers, sometimes white. Found in woodlands. The bell-shaped scented flowers grow on a spike and the leaves are long and thin. Is your bluebell the true British bluebell? This has its flowers along one side so it droops over to one side, and the pollen inside the flowers is creamy white.

## Wild Strawberry

*Fragaria vesca*

This grows low to the ground. It has white flowers with five petals and a yellow centre. The leaves have three parts like a clover leaf (trefoil). The leaves are shiny on top, hairy underneath and have toothed edges. It is found in dry grassy places and in woods. In late summer and autumn, it will have tiny strawberries.
